

Tanzania Chartered 22 New clubs in a year going from 18 to 40 in just 12 months

The Rotarians who brought them all together are now using their efforts to "Kick Out Polio"

To raise awareness and money to support this endeavor, by special arrangement Rotary Club of Moshi is offering sponsored climbs up Kilimanjaro and visits to the National Parks in the North and the coast to raise funds for Polio. The idea is that those who come raise their own sponsorship to climb Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest mountain, to kick a ball on the beautiful coast at Tanga, or to visit Tanzania's world famous National Parks.

Tanzania, despite being one of the poorest countries in the world, is a friendly place. The people are warm and charming, and the landscape is spectacular. Where else can one travel across a country with a stunning coastline with palm trees and warm seas in the South, to huge mountains, with tropical rain forests and the Great Rift Valley in the North. Don't forget of course to come and see the amazing big five animals and the stunning flora that abounds in the numerous wildlife parks such as the Serengeti and Ngorongoro Crater.

Tanzania also boasts a tropical island paradise. With its luxurious beaches of white sand, historical past and the ancient Stone Town, Zanzibar is an amazing destination to add to the end of a worthwhile trip.

Besides this visits can also be arranged to local projects, handicraft centers where you can see polio victims producing amazing handicraft, traditional dancers, a sundowner at a colonial home where you can chat with people who have lived in Tanzania for over 50 years. The limit is only your imagination.

US\$1000 will be paid to Rotary International for the fight against polio by special arrangement through the Rotary Club of Moshi by some tour operators. This will be given from their profits and at no extra charge to the tourist.

We are also offering Mountain Climbs and kicking a football either along the coast, up Mount Kilimanjaro or through the game parks. In these the participants look for sponsors, each participant will be expected to raise \$2000 for the fight against Polio plus the cost of the trip.

This \$1000 will cover the cost of vaccination of 1660 children.

So think about what you can do for Tanzania, and what Tanzania can do for you. If you decide you want a holiday with a purpose, then what better than supporting Polio immunization, so that our children the world over, will never have to suffer the affects of this dreadful disease again.
